

V-LEAGUE CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ALL COACHES/PLAYERS/PARENTS/FANS

All participants will be expected to abide by the following V-League philosophy:

1. Emphasize the proper ideals of sportsmanship, ethical conduct and fair play.
2. Stress the values derived from playing the game fairly.
3. Respect the integrity and judgement of game officials. There will be no disputing judgement calls. Coaches, players and fans shall not indulge in conduct that will incite others against the officials.
4. Any removal from a facility will require a letter to the Board of Directors requesting reinstatement.
5. Respect the integrity and judgement of Division Directors and Board Members.
6. V-League has zero tolerance for verbal or physical abuse. Any physical contact with game or league officials will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
7. Show respect for all players, officials, and coaches at all times.
8. Use discretion when providing constructive criticism.
9. Achieve a thorough understanding and acceptance of the rules of the game.
10. Use of profanity, vulgarity and other offensive language and gestures will not be tolerated.
11. Recognize that the purpose of athletics is to promote the physical, mental, social and emotional well being of the individual players.
12. Violation of these rules by you or any of your guests may result in technical fouls being assessed to the team represented and may include the temporary or permanent suspension of your privileges as a participant. Further disciplinary action will be at the discretion of the V-League Board of Directors.
13. **Let the coaches coach, let the players play, and let the supporters support!**
